Dealing with grief is challenging, especially for children and teens.

Drew's Hope, a support program for children, teens and their families, utilizes student and faculty volunteers from Shippensburg University's Counseling Department and Growing Edges Community Counseling Clinic

Children and teens will participate in age appropriate activities and discussion while adults will meet in separate groups to share memories of their loved one, gain support from other adults and discuss how to help their children cope.

The program's seven Tuesday night sessions are offered at no cost. A free meal is provided with each session.

Drew's Hope will be held seven Tuesday nights from Sept. 15 - Dec. 1, 2009 at the Luhr's Elementary School on the campus of Shippensburg University.
